STUDENT RETENTION REQUEST Due March 31

Occasionally a student may need additional time to complete grade requirements. Retention is seldom recommended for students beyond the primary grades. Retention alone does not benefit a child. Therefore, a plan should be developed using alternative strategies, techniques and materials to help the student meet goals. For the highest success, parents must agree that retention is in the best interest.

Southwestern Union Education Code Retention of Students (4124)

Consideration to retain the student at a given level involves counseling with the student and the parents early in the third quarter. A written report, signed by teacher and parent, must be sent to the Education Director following the meeting.

No student is to be retained for more than two years during the elementary school years. All efforts are to be made to assist the student. The final decision to retain a student is to be reached cooperatively, and the Education Director must be consulted. Final notification must reach the Education Department by March 31.
